

Drug and Alcohol Policy

CCNY is a dry campus and the possession of alcohol or other illegal paraphernalia at The Towers may result in your immediate removal and sanctions upon your return. Please note that your respective school may be notified of any violations.

Lock-Outs

If at any time you are to be without Residents are permitted to have keys or a keycard and cannot gain entry to your room, you must go to the Welcome Desk located in the first floor lobby and inform them that you are locked out. The security personnel will contact the Resident Assistant who will then let you into your room.

- There are five (5) free lockouts. After the fifth lock-out there will be a \$50.00 charge for every subsequent lock out after.
- During normal business hours (Monday - Friday, 9am-5pm) to receive entry into your room, you must go to the office.

Overnight Guests

overnight guests who come between 12am-8am. However, overnight guests may not stay more than three consécutive days in a sevenday period.

Guest Policy

Each resident is allowed up to ten people (guests and residents included) in their suite at any given time. When signing in a guest, both resident and guest(s) must present a state-issued or school issued, valid photo identification to the Courtesy Officer upon entry to the building. All non-Resident guests must be accompanied at all times while in common areas of the building (i.e., lounges, seminar Resident hosts may not leave their guest(s) unaccompánied in suite for more than 4 hours.
