DID YOU KNOW?



Even those brand new pair of jeans you just bought from the store may actually be the home for bed bugs.

When purchasing new clothing it is always a good idea to wash them in warm water before wearing them or putting them in your closet.

Bed bugs can be picked up through public transit, having someone visit your home, or purchasing a piece of infested furniture or used electronics.

Bed bugs can spread very easily and can reproduce rapidly, so don't fool yourself into thinking you're too good for them.

Many times, live bed bugs will "hitchhike" on backpacks and jackets. Yet another reason to keep your distance on the subway. Close inspection can easily reveal these bugs before you set them in your house.

It is easy to spread a bed bug problem to a new location.

A bed bug infestation begins when the bugs or eggs are brought in from an infested environment to a previously un-infested one.

Bed bugs can live anywhere!

Bed bugs don't care if you are wealthy or poor, and they don't care if your house is dirty or clean.

Quick Tips:

- 1. Do not pickup or buy used furniture at yard sales, roadsides or dumps.
- 2. Wash beddings weekly in hot water and machine dry on high.
- 3. Keep it clean! Clutter gives bed bugs many places to hide and protects them from control efforts.
